The second quote presented at that meeting was received from Allegra Marketing Print Mail in Reno, NV. On November 17, 2023, the Utah Correctional Industries - Print Shop informed City staff that they would not be able to complete the print order for an out-of-state municipality. City staff were recommended to contact Allegra Marketing Print Mail and obtain another quote from them. City staff received the quote and print order proof from Allegra Marketing Print Mail.
